School Activity Pass

All employees of the District shall be given yearly family passes to all school activities. Any employee who has completed 20 years of service to the District shall be recognized with a lifetime pass to all school activities. A life-time pass will also be given School Board members who have served at least two (2) terms in office. The Superintendent or Board may also grant a yearly or life-time pass to any person who has made a significant contribution to the District or community.

Former students who are attending institutions of higher learning may, for a period not to exceed five (5) years from date of graduation, make a request at the administration office for an activity pass. The Board reserves the right to cancel or refuse such a pass upon recommendation of the administration.

Persons in the District who are sixty-five (65) years of age or older and have lived in the District for five (5) or more years may, upon request at the administration office, receive annual passes to all school activities. These passes shall represent a small token of appreciation from the Board for all that these people have done for the District over the years.
