AES/AMS Remote Learning Plan 2020-2021

- Students will log on daily from 1:00pm-3:40pm for live teacher instruction on Google Meets
- Students who are unable to log in during this time will be able to see video recordings of lessons daily
- Students who have no internet access will be able to go to the closest district building from their home between 9:00am-12:00pm and 1:00pm 3:40pm daily for WIFI access only. We will use Libraries, Gyms, Cafeterias, common areas for WIFI locations. All will be required to wear a mask, wear headphones/ear pods, and practice social distancing. Students in K-2 will need a guardian/babysitter with them.
- Packets will be made available for students without internet access and can't get to a wifi area
- Attendance, grades, participation will be required and recorded daily/weekly for all classes.
- Students will have Reading and Math daily. Science/Social Studies will be offered 2-3x's per week for middle school students. Elementary students will receive phonics/writing. Teachers will instruct all lessons and have time for students to ask questions while completing work.
- Music, Art, and PE will have 1 pre-recorded lesson per week that students will be able to log into any time during the week to complete for credit outside of the normal daily instruction time.
- Resource students will be contacted on an individual basis to make sure their needs are met per law requirements.
- All teachers will have office hours that they keep daily for questions/answers sessions of students or parents as well as, small group/individual instruction where needed.
- There will be 2 parent/teacher conference days on August 24 and 25 where 1 parent/student will meet their teacher to pick up chromebooks along with any other school materials needed for remote learning. Parents will have to login to skyward and schedule a time.
- Students are to follow all school/classroom expectations during remote learning hours.
