

Pre-K Remote Learning Proposal

2020-2021

The Auburn Pre-K Program is submitting the following proposal for Remote Learning.

Schedule:

The <u>morning</u> Pre-K classes will meet daily at <u>9:00am</u>. The <u>afternoon</u> Pre-K classes will meet daily at <u>10:00am</u>. There will be a <u>30-minute class meeting</u> followed by <u>20 minutes of small group activities</u>.

Class Meeting:

The class meeting will last approximately <u>30 minutes</u>. This class meeting will include:

- <u>Read aloud</u> of quality children's literature
 - 2.A.ECa Engage in book-sharing.
 - 2.A.ECb Looks at books.
 - 2.B.ECa Ask and answer questions about books.
- Song/movement activity
 - o 25.A.ECa Movement and Dance
 - o 25.A.ECc Music
- Learning activity
 - 30.A.ECb Use communication skills
 - 31.A.ECe Develop peer relationships
 - o 31.B.ECa Interact with peers
- The class meeting will also include birthday celebrations, show and tell, and Star Student (i.e., student of the week) activities.

Small Groups:

The small groups will last approximately <u>20 minutes</u>. The schedule for small groups will be:

Monday – <u>4/</u>5 year old students – <u>literacy readiness</u> activity Tuesday – <u>3 year old</u> students – <u>literacy readiness</u> activity Wednesday – <u>4/5 year old</u> students – <u>math readiness</u> activity Thursday – <u>3 year old</u> students – <u>math readiness</u> activity Friday – <u>4/5 year old</u> students – <u>thematic</u> activity Activities will vary, but all will be aligned with the Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards for Preschool.

Additional Material:

An additional 10-15 minutes of instructional material will be provided daily. <u>Website</u> – The Pre-K website will contain additional learning videos. <u>SeeSaw</u> – Digital games and learning activities will be uploaded weekly to SeeSaw. Work Packets – Students will be provided with work packets for paper/pencil activities.

Office Hours:

Pre-K teachers will be available for office hours from <u>12:40-3:40 daily</u>. They may be contacted through email, phone, or the Remind App. They are also available for video conferencing during this time or for additional student instruction if needed.
