Attention parents of students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th, 9th, and 12th grades.

This information was recently emailed regarding health requirements for the 2020-2021 school year.

Per Illinois School Code, students in these grades will still need to submit the required health documents for their grade even though we will be learning remotely. The requirement is for any student enrolled in school and is not contingent upon in-person instruction.

Health Requirements 2020-2021

Physicals and immunizations for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year must be current and on file in the nurse's office by October 15, 2020. Please drop off or mail forms to Auburn CUSD #10, 606 North Street, Auburn, IL 62615. Please see below for health requirements or log onto the school's webpage, www.auburn.k12.il.us under Support Services, Nursing Services, and Medical Forms for more information.

Physical Examinations are required for entrance in to Pre-K, Kindergarten, Sixth, and Ninth grades. The State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form must be used. School physicals must be within one year of the first day of school. Physicals for participation in sports are good for one full year from the date the physical was performed. Please note that the History section at the top of the form MUST be completed and signed by the parent/guardian for the physical to be valid.

Up To Date Immunizations are required for entrance into Pre-K, Kindergarten, Sixth, Ninth, and Twelfth grades. Please provide proof of updated immunizations from your student's physician.

Eye Examinations are required for all students entering Kindergarten or an Illinois school for the first time. The exam must be completed within one year prior to the deadline of October 15th.

Dental Examinations are required for students entering Kindergarten, Second, Sixth, and Ninth grades. A copy of the exam report must be filed in the nurse's office no later than May 15, 2021. The law allows these exams to be done up to 18 months prior to the deadline date. This means that exams completed after November 15, 2019 will count for the 2020-2021 school year.
